



Summer Camp 2020 (summer classes and summer team program are still in the works)

As of now we are planning on holding our summer programs with the following changes and/or protocols in place. Please note all protocols and openings are subject to change based on county, state, and national guidelines and regulations. We will continue to modify protocols as the situation evolves and calls for with the utmost safety of students, campers, and staff in mind.

Up to 8 weeks available – June 29<sup>th</sup> – August 21<sup>st</sup>

2 half day sessions will be offered- 9:00-12:00 and 12:30-3:30 with option to register for both sessions – for those who might need extended day, please reach out so we can see if we can accommodate you

Cost is \$275 per week for first session (1/2 day), \$250 for each additional session (additional weeks or second ½ of day).

- Dramatic cut in the number of campers that we will register (between 25-50% of our regular capacity)
- Lower student/teacher ratio (4:1 or under)
- Note: due to the nature of gymnastics, staff will need to be hands on when necessary in order to spot children safely and adequately.
- Dedicated staff member whose primary job will be to disinfect bathrooms after each child uses it, as well as disinfect common touched surfaces throughout the day.
- No use of the water fountain. Water bottles should be brought from home.



- Stations that allow for distancing between students-- while normally our camp allows for kids to go from event to event as they like, this year we will instead be setting up stations that the kids will move through so that only one child is at each station at a time and can maintain ample distance from others.
- Each piece of equipment will be wiped down often (as in multiple times per hour and after each child wherever possible)- this includes the vault, beam, bars, trampoline, airtrack, rings, mats, trapeze, mats etc. – The floor can obviously not be wiped down but will be disinfected as often as possible. Walls, cubbies, tables, door knobs, etc will be cleaned and disinfected multiple times throughout the day and after every session.
- Ball pit will remain closed through the summer and until further notice.
- No gloves will be used during gymnastics- they are not safe for children to use during their activities nor for our coaches who need to spot safely. Coaches who might need to assist children with opening food, etc will wear disposable gloves
- Snack (and lunch for those who are staying for both sessions) will be held in shifts and set up so that there is minimum of 6 feet distance in all directions from each other including siblings to be fair and uniform- they can still sit close enough to buddies to chat and laugh and enjoy themselves
- Temp will be taken before let in for all who enter including students, staff, parents & caregivers
- Masks will be determined depending on circumstances and guidelines as we get closer to opening
- Children and staff will wash hands often including but not limiting to before and after eating as well as when activities switch. Lotion will be on hand to prevent drying out of hands.
- Arts and crafts will be in shifts tailored so that each child will have their own supplies and do not need to share and supplies will be sanitized when cleaning up before next use or discarded if not able to be sanitized



- We understand that kids are kids and as much as we tell them to keep their distance there will be some that this is hard for. We will continue to remind them and help them keep their distance but parents should be aware that we cannot promise in no way guarantee that there might not be some occasional contact although we will do our absolute best.
- Parents are welcome to come in and observe our practices as we have always been and will continue to be fully transparent however we reserve the right to request that you wait your turn to enter if there are already other parents so that we can maintain distancing.
- Drop off- for those who are comfortable dropping their child off at the door, someone will be at the door to greet them and get them situated safely. For parents who need to speak to us feel free to come in. For children who might be a little shy or nervous parents are of course welcome to walk them in and get them comfortable, however, please note you might have to wait a few minutes if we are already at capacity at the moment.
- Pick up, we will have a pick up line at the door for you to just pull up (details to follow as we get closer). We will of course do our best to answer any questions you have about the day. If there is anything we need to report to you we will notify you about the day before pick up.

Please reach out with any questions or concerns as we are always ready, willing, and able to identify other areas that we can improve upon.
